(d) behaving in an abusive, insulting, threatening or obscene manner towards or in relation to an umpire 3

(e) disputing a decision of an umpire 2

(g) intentionally, recklessly or negligently:- 2

(iii) tripping another person whether by hand, arm, foot or leg; 1

(iv) engaging in time wasting; 2

(v) charging another person; 1

(vi) throwing or pushing another Player after that Player has taken a mark, disposed of the football or after the football is otherwise out of play; 2

(vii) engaging in rough conduct against an opponent which in the circumstances is unreasonable; 1

(viii) engaging in a melee, except where a Player's sole intention is to remove a team mate from the incident 2

(h) attempting to kick another person; 2

(i) attempting to strike another person; 2

(j) attempting to trip another person whether by hand, arm, foot or leg; 1

(k) intentionally shaking a goal or behind post when another player is preparing to kick or is kicking for goal or after the player has kicked for goal and the ball is in transit; 1

(l) wrestling another person; 2

(m) using abusive, insulting, threatening or obscene language; 2

(n) failing to leave the playing surface when directed to do so by a field umpire 1

(o) wearing boots jewellery and equipment prohibited under Law 9 of the AFL Laws of the Game 1

NOTE: *If the reported player has been previously suspended in the current or the preceding season the player shall not be able to apply for the set penalty until offered by the League Secretary /General Manager. The League Secretary /General Manager is the only person empowered to decide after studying a player's tribunal history whether a player can accept the minimum prescribed penalty or will be required to attend the Tribunal hearing. If a player wishes to accept the minimum set penalty or request the matter be heard by a tribunal, the club secretary must contact the League Secretary /General Manager, no later than 12 noon on the first working day immediately following the match for approval. Such requests shall be made in writing, delivered by facsimile or email to the League Secretary/General Manager, no later than 12 noon on the first working day immediately following the match. If the report is not requested to be heard by a tribunal by any party noted below (umpire/offended player(s)/club secretary/official) the player is automatically to be given the set penalty.*
