

AFL Community Support Ticketing Program

The Australian Football League (AFL) receives many requests to assist with ticketing from a wide range of community groups including schools, junior football clubs, youth & church groups and formal organisations supporting specific disadvantaged or disability groups.

The AFL recognises it has a corporate responsibility to the broader community and therefore has provided access to our great game to community groups via a recently formalised AFL Community Support Ticketing Program. Through this program we are able to offer access to 25 selected games* throughout the year via AFL "sponsored" ticketing.

The number of tickets available per game is limited to ensure that access is maximised to as many groups as possible. Groups may obtain a maximum of thirty (30) complimentary student/child tickets and ten (10) complimentary adult tickets for the group co-ordinators. The nominated Community Support games are listed below and request fulfilment will be subject to availability.

Terms & Conditions:

1. A maximum of 30 complimentary student tickets are available per group. Additional Student tickets (for children aged 15 years and over who hold relevant concession ID) will be charged at \$12.80 each incl GST
2. If you are booking additional tickets for children under 15, please contact the AFL Ticketing department to confirm prices
3. Up to 10 complimentary Adult tickets will be provided for the group co-ordinators. Additional Adult tickets will be charged at \$20.30 each incl GST
4. Tickets provide general admission to the Public Reserve at the MCG (reserved seats are not supplied)
5. Offer is available for nominated games only. Tickets are not available for Telstra Dome or any MCG matches that do not appear in the above list
6. Organisations participating in other AFL ticket programs/initiatives are not eligible for the group ticket offer
7. Organisations are only eligible to receive group tickets for one AFL game per season
8. Tickets may not be re-sold or used for advertising, promotions or competitions
9. Tickets will not be secured or issued until payment for any additional tickets is complete
10. Tickets are not guaranteed for the games selected. All tickets will be issued on a first in best dressed basis, subject to availability
11. The AFL Ticketing department will contact you to confirm the availability of tickets for your selected match
12. Student tickets admit children under 15 or students holding relevant concession identification
13. All application forms must include the details of a senior representative of your organisation who may be contacted to verify this booking
14. Applications will only be accepted via mail and should be accompanied by a brief letter on your organisation's letterhead.
15. Eligibility for ticket offer and issuing of all tickets is at the discretion of the AFL Ticketing department
16. Applications will be accepted until 5pm Friday, August 7 2009 or until the allocation of tickets is exhausted. Applications will not be accepted after this date
